Communities In Schools of Kalamazoo is an affiliate of a national organization with presence IN schools across 26 states. Locally, CIS of Kalamazoo has formed a network of trust and collaboration with our local schools and partners to support kids in 23 school buildings. Through school-wide services, 12,000 students in these schools benefit from CIS in their building.

The mission of CIS of Kalamazoo is to surround students with a community of support, empowering them to stay in school and achieve in life. To do this, CIS site coordinators are embedded inside the school and work with school staff, community partners, and families to connect students to caring adults and community resources that help them see, confront, and overcome the barriers that stand between them and a brighter future.
